

This Water Project Recreation Act opens up a e area of possibilities, none of which are overctical. It could be a veritable Pandora's Box efuddlement. Shall the federal government exd this matter to roads and parks and national ests and demand that every community realizbenefits from them pay a part of the cost? And far down the road do you go in pursuit of dollar that is so scarce in areas such as this?

Vill these dams help protect towns and farms hamlets and even cities, miles on downstream? they worthwhile in a region under constant eat of flood? If the answer is "Yes," then let federal government get on with the job, withimposing an onerous, even impossible, burden communities which already are shouldering a vy load.

Conditions in these jails are unbelievably wretched, says de los Reyes. If physical punishment fails to break a prisoner's spirit, psychological pressure usually succeeds.

Starvation is common among prisoners. In the camp where the author was imprisoned, a 50-gallon drum of coffee-flavored water served as "breakfast" for hundreds of men. Other meals usually consisted of a watery solution with a few shriveled vegetables thrown in. Malnutrition was the inevitable result; many prisoners lost all their teeth, having to gouge them out themselves because of the lack of medical facilities. Others developed tuberculosis and dysentery.

Adding to the misery was unrelenting pressure by communist guards to convince prisoners that they've been abandoned by the free world, and that acceptance of Red doctrine holds their only hope for relief.

'I am lucky to be alive," says de los Reyess. "Yet I am sick atheart. Is it too much to expect that the United States should rally the free nations in an unceasing, uncompromising demand for an end to this infamy?"

New marketable drugs in the future will be recommended toward more specific ailments, Dr. Hopkins says, but adds that as they do so, the potential for hazard increases. The drug must be tested a long time, with any indicated side effects as a result of its consumption noted and followed through in new testing before it is finally given a go-ahead by the FDA.

In the springtime rises in the trees and you want to shake off the sedentary, sluggish days of winter, Dr. Hopkins says he would recommend a cup of sassafras tea, that is, if you have a taste for this brew. "It may not cure all your ills." he says, "but it won't hurt you. and if you believe that it will help you, then it probably will make you feel better.' The UK professor concludes: "Frankly, I like the taste of sassafras tea. I drink it whenever I get it."

the proposal of the Prestonsburg Municipal Housing Commission to include existing county property in its project, Floyd county would not be constructing a new courthouse, and public use of the existing courthouse property is being discontinued solely because of the undertaking of the Urban Renewal Project."

"Progress" -- A One-Man Effort?

Mr. Sturgill's letter would seem to indicate that many other people made worthwhile contributions toward the construction of our new courthouse. program were selected on the basis of their income and NOT BY MY OPPONENT. If credit is to be given for this program I should think Congressman Carl D. Perkins would be high on the list.

(5) COMMUNITY COLLEGE: The Prestonsburg Community College is a result of the combined efforts of literally hundreds of people. The Governor's Commission for the Study of Education recommended the program to the legislature which subsequently passed the enabling legislation. The people of Floyd county rallied to the cause; COAL MINERS, DOCTORS, BANKERS, BUSINESSMEN, RADIO STATIONS AND NEWS-PAPERS, TEACHERS AND EDUCATORS, AND YES, SCHOOL CHILDREN gave their time, dollars and pennies to acquire the land upon which the college now sits. I participated in that project as the attorney who prepared the articles of incorporation of the Big Sandy College Development Corporation and now serve as its secretary. I also abstracted the title to a portion of the land. I performed all of these services FREE.

#### (1) NEW COURTHOUSE:

· ·

The first effort to construct a new courthouse began in 1960, before my opponent took office. A \$7,500.00 planning advance was made available for preliminary plans and specifications. On this occasion I made a trip to the Housing and Home Finance Agency in Atlanta, Georgia, along with the

County Judge, the Architect and a Prestonsburg banker. At that time, as well as later, the new courthouse project was being initiated in conjunction with the City of Prestonsburg and the Prestonsburg Municipal Housing Commission.

In January, 1962, after my opponent took office, the Prestonsburg Municipal Housing Commission and myself, as Executive Director, approached the Fiscal Court and offered to purchase the old county property as a part of its Urban Renewal Project. From the very beginning, the new courthouse was a City-County Project. The best evidence on this fact is an excerpt from a letter written on October 40, 1963, from County Attorney Barkley J. Sturgill to E. Bruce Wedge, Regional Director of Urban Renewal, Atlanta, Georgia. The excerpt is as follows:

"This is to advise your office that the planning of Ky. R-43 and the construction of the new Floyd County Courthouse has been undertaken as a City-County Project. Preliminary discussions and negotiations were initiated immediately after January 1, 1962, with the election of a new City Council in the City of Prestonsburg."

"Mr. Latta and myself have worked closely in the planning of both the courthouse and Urban Renewal Project, in order that we might be able to take timely steps to expedite the ultimate completion of the total project, that is, construction of the new Floyd County Courthouse and installation of public parking facilities by the City of Prestonsburg. Without

It is not my intention to detract from any of the above programs or to make light of the efforts which may have been put forth by the present County Attorney. However, I could not fail to challenge the inferences raised by such statements. My point is simply this: Most of the programs would have become a reality even if we didn't have a County Attorney. PROGRESS is not the product of ONE MAN—IT IS THE RESULT OF THE COMBINED EFFORTS OF OFFICE HOLDERS AND CITIZENS, ON ALL LEVELS, WORKING TOGETHER!

My opponent's road signs make this statement: "DON'T STOP PROGRESS FOR ALL OF FLOYD COUNTY." He obviously infers that if you do not elect him as your County Attorney, all programs will stop. I earnestly believe that I have made a substantial contribution to the PROG-

(2) CLEARING AND SNAGGING RIGHT BEAVER: This project was planned and programed by the United States Army, Corps of Engineers and would have been completed if JOHN DOE had been County Attorney.

(3) FOOD STAMP PROGRAM: The food stamp program was begun in 1961 by the United States Department of Agriculture as a PILOT program in Floyd county, Kentucky, and McDowell county, West Virginia. The parents working under this (6) ANTI-POVERTY PROGRAM ADVANCE PLAN-NING MONEY, \$23,900.00: The funds were acquired under the sponsorship of the FLOYD COUNTY PLANNING AND DE-VELOPMENT CORPORATION of which I was a charter member and attorney, and now serve as a member of its board of directors. The work of this group has been carried on for many months by many persons from all over Floyd county. Mr. Sturgill became "active" ONLY after I announced my candidacy for the office of County Attorney. AGAIN the legal services performed by me were FREE.

(7) EXTENSIVE RURAL ROAD PROGRAM: The people who are served by rural roads are best qualified to comment on this item of "PROGRESS"!






