Woman quilty of lying about identity to cops

PRESTONSBURG — An Allen woman has pleaded guilty to lying to police officers when she gave them a false name while they were serving a warrant on her that was issued in Pike

Maronda Gay Mitchell, 31, entered her plea Friday morning in front of District Judge James Allen and was fined \$100 for hiding from police and then ving them the false name, Sandy Mullins, when they found her hiding in the bedroom of a friend's home Thursday evening. She was also ordered to be held for Pike County authorities, who are seeking her in connection with a theft charge. The Pike County

complaint alleges that Mitchell stole \$382.76 from the Coal Run Cardinal Mart on May 14. She was allegedly videotaped giving 11 cartons of cigarettes, two rolls of Skoal and a carton of Longhorn snuff to a customer without ringing up the items.

Murder trial set to get underway

PRESTONSBURG — Testimony is expected to begin tomorrow in the trial of James Hunt, 58, of Martin, who stands accused of the November 2004 murder of his estranged wife, Bettina.

The proceedings actually began last week with jury selection. However, the prosecution is seeking the death penaltyin the case, which has necessitated pro-

longed interviews with potential jurors, during which the attorneys question the jury pool to determine if they can hear the case without any preconceived notions of guilt or innocence. In a capital case, the judge takes over a large portion of the questioning to ascertain if the jurors feel that they can impose the death penalty should they find the defendant guilty.

The case began when the Floyd County Sheriff's Department responded to a 911 call made from Bettina Hunt's arrived at her Buck's Branch home, they found her shot to death and lying just a few feet from a crib holding an infant, who Sheriff John K Blackburn later transported to Our Lady of the Way Hospital.

Hunt was taken into custody at Buck's Branch Creek, where he had wrecked his Pontiac Grand Am in a creek which had risen after heavy rain. He was taken into custody and charged with operating a motor vehicle under the influence of drugs or alco-

home on Nov. 30, 2004. When authorities hol, driving without insurance and driving a vehicle with an expired registration. He was charged with the murder later that evening after receiving medical treatment.

A previous trial date was postponed when Hunt's defense attorneys petitioned the court to have their own experts present at all evidence testing for the case.

The couple had a history of marital stress, with several appearances in family court, and were separated at the time of the incident.

Senator's trial delayed until September

FRANKFORT — The United States District Court postponed a scheduled June 12 trial date for state Sen. Johnny Turner and cousin case. A similar motion was and campaign treasurer, Loren Glenn Turner, who are facing two counts of conspiracy to commit mail fraud and one count of aiding in mail fraud. The case harkens back to

the Democratic primary race of 2000, in which Sen. Turner defeated former Sen. Benny Ray Bailey, and stems from an Federal Bureau of Investigation probe which concluded that the Turners and Pike County attorney Ross Harris amended a post-election campaign finance report that was sent to the Kentucky Registry for Election Finance. The indictment alleges that vote hauling funds were actually

used to influence voters and that Harris and Turner used "straw contributors," who were repaid for contributions to Turner's campaign.

The continuance is the second one sought in the granted in December when attorneys for Turner asked that the court await the outcome of a Court of Appeals ruling on a similar case in which Harris and Loren Glen Turner were found guilty of similar charges.

The latest motion for continuance was granted on May 15 in a ruling issued by Judge Karen Caldwell. following a telephone con-

"This court has determined that the ends of justice outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendants," Caldwell wrote in granting the request.

The trial has been rescheduled for Sept. 26.

Grand jury investigating governor to have term extended

FRANKFORT - A judge on Friday said he would extend the term of a special grand jury that indicted Gov. Ernie Fletcher last week on misdemeanor charges of illegal hiring practices.

On the day the grand jury's term was due to expire, Franklin County Circuit

Judge William Graham said he would offenses pardoned by the governor. allow the grand jury to meet for another 90 days.

The extension follows a Kentucky Supreme Court ruling Thursday that validated Fletcher's sweeping pardon last summer of anyone in his administration except himself who might face charges in the probe. Kentucky's high court also ruled the grand jury may indict people for


Thursday's ruling also meant the grand jury may issue a report on its findings, but is prohibited from naming individuals covered by the amnesty.



Could speed limit soften gas crisis?

Canadians in Ottawa are testing out a system that combines onboard Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) technology with a digital speed limit map. It looks like and works like the dash mounted GPS navigation systems available on recent highend automobiles and SUVs.

However — here's the catch.

And catch is an appropriate word because instead of helping you find where you're going, this GPS system will prevent you from getting there any faster than the posted speed limit for the route you've selected.

That's right. Big Brother will indeed be watching you; more accurately, the GPS system will be tied to your ability to accelerate. Traffic safety do-gooders are of course in absolute ecstasy at the possibility of preventing speeding. There's some realistic concern about speeding and the lives (particularly, the young lives) lost each year. Consistently, and across the nation, drivers now exceed the speed limit, on average, by 6 to 12 miles per hour each and every time we get behind the wheel.

But there's another element: the soaring price of fuel.

Some will argue that our oil addiction should suggest the same solution that worked back in the 1970s during the nation's first energy crisis: bring back the 55 mph speed limit. Improvements in automobile fuel efficiency followed, together with a reduction in fuel consumption for the first time in American postwar history between 1974 and 1984.

Energy eventually became cheap again, and almost in a childish reaction at being told we couldn't have something, we immediately began building bigger cars, eventually ending up the monstrously sized and gas-guzzling SUVs.

And, of course, we raised the speed limit back to 65 mph, and in many places ... increased it to 70 mph once exiting city traffic on the Interstates.

It can also be argued that the current high price of gas has to do with Americas return to its oil glut youth - and that together with a Chinese and Russian entry into the free enterprise marketplace, this has dramatically increased demand and price along with it. That keeps current stockholders happy — and keeps energy companies that are in power (no pun intended) today, also in power tomorrow.

An oil conspiracy so vast

The cackling oil executives have returned. They are the guys who sit

around corporate boardrooms and decide how high the price of gas will be at the pump, rubbing their hands greedily and emitting squeals of Mephistophelean laughter all the while. These executives exist only in the imaginations of economic dema-

gogues, but that doesn't make them seem any less real to Americans who are gripped by petroleum paranoia every time they don't like the price of gaso-

How powerful and resourceful must be the cackling executives? Boundlessly. president Mahmoud Ahmadinejad might strike most observers as deeply irrational, unworried about possibly prompting a nuclear exchange one day in the Middle East. But this interpretation misses the true measure of the man. Oil executives apparently have his ear: Why else would

he do them such a huge favor by driving up world crude prices with his nuclear

Once you're clued in to the alleged power of the cackling executives, their influence extends everywhere. With al-Qaida — its threat against Saudi Arabia keeps the world market good and jittery.

> With rebels in Nigeria — who maintain they are fighting for the rights of the Ijaw tribe in the Niger delta, but whose guerrilla war conveniently disrupts Nigerian oil production. With Chad — the corruptly governed African nation

that is threatening to cut off its production in a dispute with the World Bank.

This is all on the supply side of the price equation, but world demand mattoo. Chinese Premier Deng Xiaoping must have been just as concerned about Texaco's profits as the economic well-being of his countrymen when he launched China's market revolution 30 years ago. The resulting economic growth means that the country is slurping up ever more oil - and driving up world prices, in a benefit to youknow-who.

Then there's the cackling executives'

most inspired manipulation of all - the change of seasons. Without winter turning to summer, there would be no need to make the shift over in seasonal blends of gasoline, with the inevitable pinch in supply that comes with it.

Of course, there is a less seductively simple explanation of rising gas prices than that a handful of oil executives have planned it. In a world market, prices will go up and go down, and the forces that play into those trends are large, complicated and mostly uncon-

The foolish conceit of our politics is that the oil market works only when prices go down. When the prices go up, it's a scandal. So Speaker of the House Dennis Hastert and Majority Leader Bill Frist — showing either a dismaying attraction to the moronic or a desire to pretend to have such an attraction have called on President Bush to investigate price gouging by the oil compa-

Maybe such an investigation will unravel a vast conspiracy of cackling executives, and the Federal Trade Commission will have to raid those corporate boardrooms to restore world crude-oil prices to their natural, low equilibrium. Such, at least, is the fevered dream of the petroleum paranoiacs.

The film opens with an exorcism that goes horribly awry when a possessed prostitute head-butts the priest into next week. At that moment the church's go-to man bursts into the room and administers an unholy smackdown on the evil escort. He starts out by getting all worldwide wrestling on the hooker from hades and appears to be trying to literally

beat the devil out of her before giving in and simply slashing her to death. It's a frenzied sequence that sets the tone for the rest of the

Turns out that the demon killer, Greyman, sort of works for the church and

reports directly to a Cardinal White who keeps him on retainer for when exorcisms go wrong. White describes him as a renegade angel who is the offspring of a coupling between a fallen angel and a human which apparently has been going on for years and is about to reach its apex with a dark one in town who means to create an army of demonic children by impregnating every prostitute in Hollywood in a plan that was probably endorsed by Andrew Dice Clay.

The demon has a succubus who works with him and she gets the job of spying on Greyman, which she does by appearing to him in his dreams and trying to seduce him. Her attempt almost works, but Greyman is saved by the timely arrival of a nun who is sent to aid him by Cardinal White. Unfortunately, she turns out to be a dud who is unwilling to lay out punishment, though she offers to compensate for her weakness by placing herself in harm's way for Greyman. She argues that her presence could buy him precious seconds when he faces the demon and offers to take a satanic bullet for him. Greyman has no problem with the plan and decides to take her along to the demon's lair, where he expects they'll both be killed by the demon, his succubus and his possessed horde of hookers.

The climax features plenty of action as the pair infiltrate the demon's skid row lair and duke it out while trying to avoid tripping over the stoned out denizens of the crack house where the demon has set up shop. There's a surprising revelation or two about characters you only think you knew and the earth is saved, until the inevitable sequel.

What is most refreshing about this film is that it appears to have been edited with a chainsaw. Any scene which would have explained the plot was cut and the result is a movie that moves like a freight train. The downside is that it's hard to follow what is going on, but you get just enough details to keep up.



LEXINGTON - Bryan Howard, a standout on Transylvania's nationally ranked men's basketball team, and Holly Gibson, the Heartland Conference Softball Player of the Year, were named male and female Pioneer Athletes of the Year during Wednesday's 13th annual Athletic Awards ceremony at Hall Field.

Howard, a native of Whitesburg, was a four-year letter-winner and a three-time selection to the All-Heartland Conference team. Football American Coaches Association Walter Camp Foundation Sporting News Football Writers Association of America.

Because the selectors of these four All-America teams can place centers in a "mix" of offensive linemen that includes guards and tackles, their 11- man first teams can often have two centers. Our policy is to count all players that play primarily the center position for their respective teams as centers, even though they maybe listed as guards or tackles on

the four All American teams. The center with the most first team votes will be determined the winner. If there is a tie with first team votes, then the center with most second team votes will win. If there is a tie with first team votes, then the center with most second team votes will win. If there is still a tie, the winner will be determined by the

Rimington Trophy committee. The winner will be honored at the awards banquet at the Rococo Theater in Lincoln, Nebraska, in January 2007.




