# Old Court Order Of Court Session Being Broken Up By Feudists

Recent disorder in Clay, Harlan and Boone counties, which have made it necessary to call on the National Guard in order to hold court, have reminded the fact that this is not by any means a new condition in Kentucky. On the term of the court there were armed factions in the town of Hazard, the French and Ervold families, antagonistic to each other. On the second night of the term, the acting judge was shot at, though not wounded, in the French end of the town. French not being in the town at the time, but some of his men were there. The next evening at dusk a man or other carriage with a gun was fired at, and the carriage was damaged and exploded heavily in the middle of the house.

On the fourth day, when the fact was known, heavy cross firing at Hazard was in progress, and near the courthouse which completely surrounded the court, the officers and people in court for some time.
