QUICK BUCKWHEAT CAKES

- 1 1/2 cup flour, 1/2 cup buckwheat flour, 1 1/2 teaspoon baking powder, 1 1/2 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons sugar, 1 1/2 cups buckwheat flour, 1 cup buttermilk...

BACON PANCAKES

- To the dry ingredients, for standard batter cakes, add 1 cup of hot fat from the frying pan...

RABBIT CRUMB BATTER CAKES

- 1/2 cup of soft bread crumbs in water 10 minutes. Press out all moisture and mix with 1 cup sugar...

APPLE BATTER CAKES

- Select tart, juicy cooking apples. Pare, core and cut in rather small thin slices...

PINEAPPLE BATTER CAKES

- Prepare like standard batter cakes, except that instead of 1 cup milk, 1 1/2 cup of pineapple juice, 3/4 cup of milk and 3/4 cup of pineapple pulp are used...

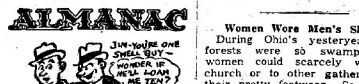

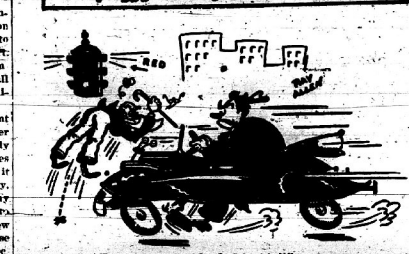
