Dear Judge Young:

Referring to our letter of the 2nd instant with reference to deed for right-of-way desired by the L & N Railroad, and your reply of the 6th.

Letter received today from Mr. Raymond quotes from a letter from Chief Engineer of Construction of the L & N on this matter, as follows:

"Please refer to correspondence relative to deed for right-of-way on Yonts and Potters Forks and especially to my letter of August 9th, 1922, which, together with draft of deed was handed you by Mr. A. A. Spitzer, one of our Resident Engineers, on September 27th. Please advise when I may expect return of the deed properly executed.

This matter has been dragging along since 1913 and there is no reason now why it cannot be completed. I will greatly appreciate your co-operation in bringing it to a conclusion".

I discussed this matter with President Fleming today over the telephone and he suggested that you prepare the kind of deed you want and send it here for execution. Will then have it passed upon by our Executive Committee or Board and arrange to have it turned over to the L & N, either through you or Mr. Raymond, whichever you prefer. Then if that does not suit them, we can tell them that that ends the matter so far as we are concerned.
