Dear Sir:-

I have your personal letter of January 8th relative to deed for right-of-way on Yonts and Potters Forks desired by the I&N Railroad. I also have the following letter from the Chief Engineer of Construction of the I&N wanting to know what has been done in the matter:

Please refer to correspondence relative to deed for right-of-way on Yonts and Potters Forks, and especially to my letter of August 9th, 1922, which, together with draft of deed was handed you by Mr. A. A. Spitzer, one of our Resident Engineers, on September 27th. Please advise when I may expect return of the deed properly executed.

This matter has been dragging along since 1913 and there is no reason now why it cannot be completed. I will greatly appreciate your co-operation in bringing it to a conclusion.

This matter has been one continual source of trouble to me for the last seven years and I can see no reason why these deeds are not drawn satisfactory to ourselves and given to the I&N people. If the Legal Department wants to handle the situation I am perfectly willing for them to do so, but I want it taken out of my hands so I am not to be bothered with it continually.

Please advise.
