Dear Sir:-

In reference to above memo the matter of incorporating the City of Wayland has been delayed pending the Vice President's decision as to where the executive center of the town would be. I understand that this decision has been made recently, and that the mouth of Steels Creek will be the center of incorporation. Mr. Fleming directed that the matter be taken up with the attorneys and necessary steps taken for them and ourselves to obtain the incorporation at the next term of the court, the decision as to the center of incorporation not having been made in time for action at the last term of court which, I believe, was in January.

Under the law only one quarter mile from any given point can be first incorporated, but extension of this area can then be made indefinitely.
